She has prosecuted and tried a variety of felony cases including Domestic Violence and Infant homicides, Child Molest, Torture, Attempted Murder, Elder Abuse and Domestic Violence. As of 2022 Claudia transitioned to the role of Executive Director of One Safe Place, the North County San Diego's Family Justice Center where survivors of Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault, Human Trafficking, Elder Abuse and Child Abuse can receive comprehensive wrap-around services. Upon the opening of One Safe Place, the South County Family Justice Center, she now manages both centers assuring that all victims seeking services obtain consistent, kind and dignified services. Claudia is also a past president of the San Diego Domestic Violence Council and being bi-lingual, bi-cultural and first-generation college graduate, regularly trains and does outreach to our Spanish speaking community. Prior to law school, Claudia was a Middle School teacher and counselor. She received her Juris Doctor from the University of San Diego School of Law, a Master's degree from Harvard University Graduate School of Education and a Bachelor of Arts from UCLA.
